

Why Call the Director?

Whenever something happens while playing that is not supposed to happen, you should call the Director to the table.

For instance, if the bidding goes 1D – P – 1S – 1H.

The heart bid is not right. It is called an insufficient bid.

What do you do? You Stop play and call the Director.

Why?

*You call the Director to **PROTECT** everyone (even yourself).
Don't listen to someone who says it is OK not to call the
Director.*

*The game of bridge is meant to be as **fair** as possible.*

*If someone makes a mistake, it could change the play or
score and, thus, cause the game to be unfair for all players.*

*So, to avoid an unfair game and maintain the integrity of
the game, the Director should be called. The Director will
determine the next course of action.*

You are not 'telling on' the offender, you are protecting them!
